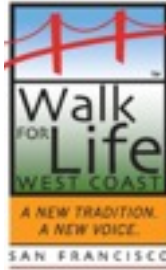

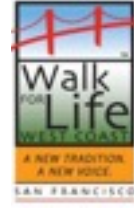

## ***What to bring...***

- ❖ ONE suitcase
- ❖ ONE small carry-on bag/backpack/day pack
- ❖ Food for bus
- ❖ Drivers License, St. Mary's ID
- ❖ Mobile phones<sup>+</sup> (used ICE - in case of emergency!)
- ❖ Mobile phone charger
- ❖ WARM clothing (can be very windy and cold)
- ❖ Layers (thermal/flannel tops & bottoms)
- ❖ Shoes with tread (sneakers)
- ❖ Sleeping bag\*\*\*\*
- ❖ Sleeping mat\*\*\*\*
- ❖ Small pillow
- ❖ Appropriate sleepwear\*\*
- ❖ Hand towel
- ❖ Toiletries (soap, shampoo, dryer, personal items, baby wipes)
- ❖ Rosary
- ❖ Prayer books (Magnificat, devotionals)
- ❖ Recreational reading
- ❖ Food money (Plan on paying for 3-4 meals, snacks, meals, water, etc.)
- ❖ Spending money (souvenirs, etc.)
- ❖ Umbrella / rain poncho
- ❖ Camera (*optional*)
- ❖ Journal & pen
- ❖ Bible
- ❖ Playing cards (*optional*)
- ❖ Money belt (*optional*)

+ Student mobile phones will be supervised by chaperones, only used when needed.

\*\*\*\* Sleeping arrangements will be divided according to gender, and chaperones will be located with each group.
