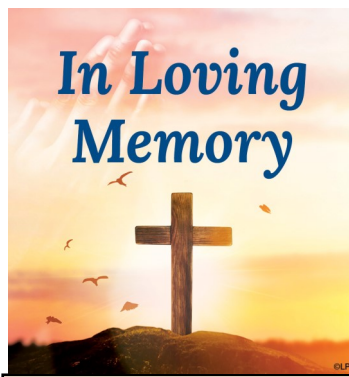

Today I am leaving for my annual silent retreat and will be gone until the middle of next week. Every priest is asked to take a retreat each year. A retreat is a time for us to heed the Lord's invitation to, *"Come away by yourselves to a deserted place and rest a while"* (Mark 6:31). Jesus himself took time to be with his Father in prayer and this is the same thing priests do while on retreat. I will be heading to a retreat center in the mountains of Honduras where a Franciscan (CFR) priest will be my director for the duration of the retreat. This typically means I will meet with him once a day to talk about what the Lord is doing in my life and during prayer while on the retreat. It will be nice to completely unplug from email, internet, phone, etc. Please keep me in your prayers while I am gone for a fruitful and rejuvenating retreat.

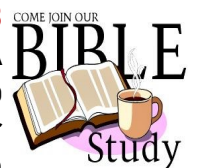
