Happy Sunday!

The General Election season is fast approaching. A quick note from the Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches, "Conscience must be informed and moral judgment enlightened. A well-informed conscience is upright and truthful. The education of conscience is indispensable for human beings who are subjected to negative influences and tempted by sin to prefer their own judgment and to reject authoritative teachings" (1783). A few of the most important non-negotiable issues involve *"protection of life in all its stages, from the first moment of conception until natural death, Recognition and promotion of the natural structure of the family—as a union between a man and a woman based on marriage—and its defense from attempts to make it juridically equivalent to radically different forms of union which in reality harm it and contribute to its destabilization, obscuring its particular character and its irreplaceable social role; the protection of the rights of parents to educate their children."*

Catholics must unite to preserve our laws that support life, human flourishing, the good, true and beautiful. We cannot afford to be silent and not participate in this election. Especially Proposition 139 which will allow abortion throughout all nine months, take away parent's rights to vote to even know about their minor's abortion, restrict the state from putting any regulations on abortion clinics, along with so many devastating consequences it will enshrine abortion into our Arizona Constitution. **VOTE NO ON PROPOSITION 139!**

Algunas de las cuestiones no negociables más importantes incluyen *“la protección de la vida en todas sus etapas, desde el primer momento de la concepción hasta la muerte natural, el reconocimiento y la promoción de la estructura natural de la familia –como la unión entre un hombre y una mujer basada en el matrimonio– y su defensa de los intentos de hacerla jurídicamente equivalente a formas radicalmente diferentes de unión que en realidad la dañan y contribuyen a su desestabilización, oscureciendo su carácter particular y su papel social irremplazable; la protección de los derechos de los padres a educar a sus hijos”*.

Los católicos deben unirse para preservar nuestras leyes que apoyan la vida, el florecimiento humano, lo bueno, lo verdadero y lo bello. No podemos permitirnos el lujo de permanecer en silencio y no participar en estas elecciones. 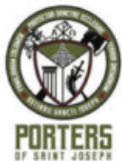
It is very important to support them at this critical time since they have no income and there is no tourism at all. In order to survive, they have turned to Christian communities in the United States to purchase their articles.

These hand carved religious articles are beyond description. Carved from wood of the sacred Olive tree, this workmanship has been traditional for these families for hundreds of years. It is hoped that through the efforts of Mr. Khair, these families who have little income will be able to stay living and survive in the Holy Land.

Sadly enough, the Christian population dropped from 22 % to less than 2% in the last 20 years. Thank you in advance for your support.

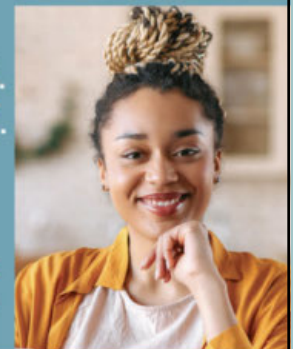

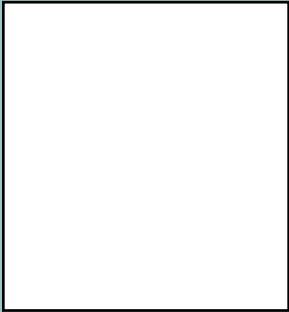
