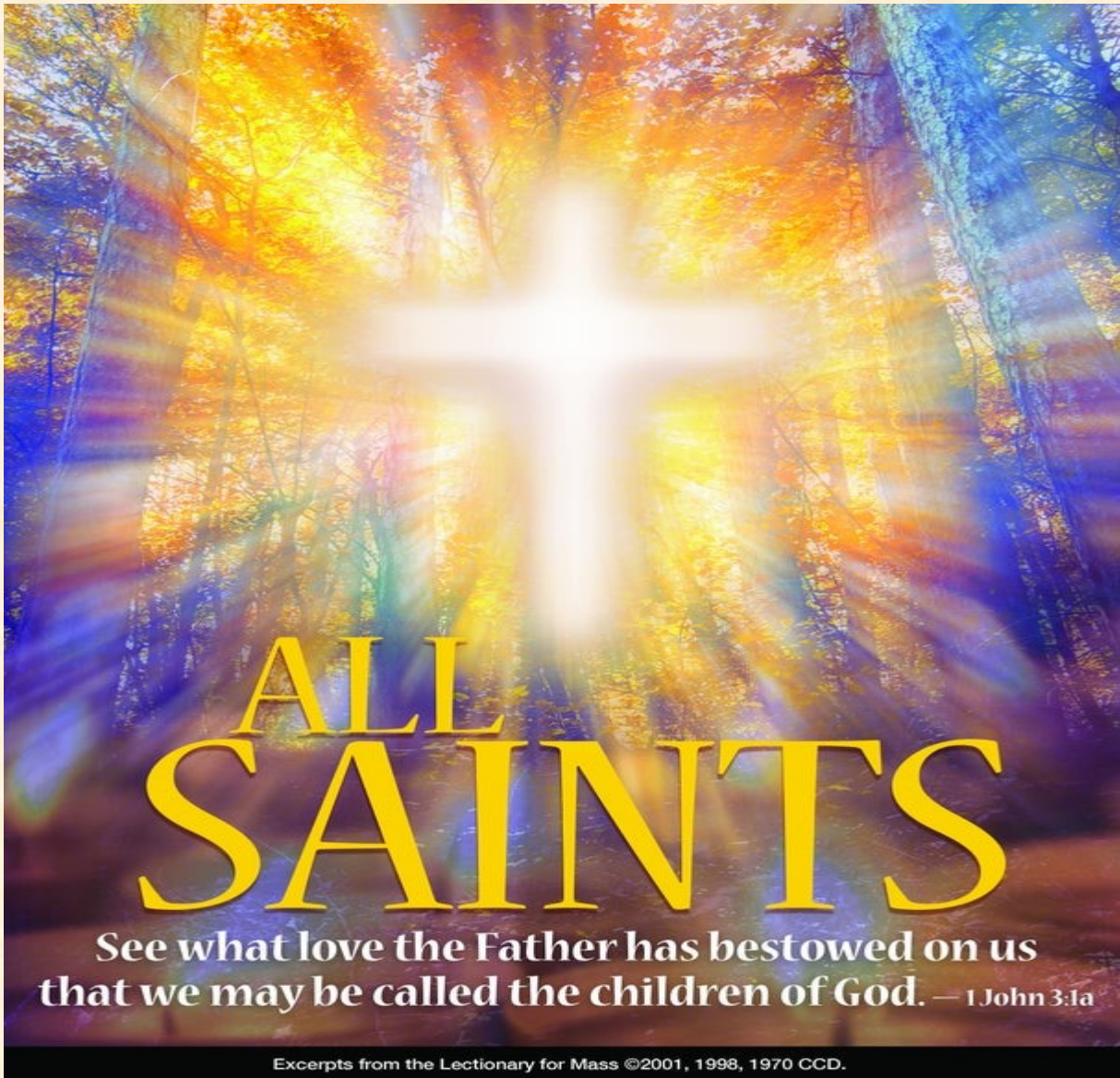

Happy Sunday!

After spending a few days on a retreat in Assisi I have returned with a gratitude to be home. Though here in Phoenix the leaves may not turn quite as they do in Assisi, but the rhythm of the liturgical year always invites us to a deeper transformation of heart and that is the change that truly matters. We are drawn to a deeper faith, humility and trust in God and perseverance in living as sons and daughters.

What a beautiful line from sacred scripture to help us reflect on our life thus far: *I have competed well; I have finished the race; I have kept the faith.* This is a deep conviction of our hearts. Saint Paul knows his time is near, yet holds no fear. Why? He knows who he is. He trusts in the just judge, who sees all, even when others fail to stand by him. His words offer a powerful encouragement to all of us, especially when we feel unrecognized or abandoned in our efforts to serve the Lord. When we remain little before God, we experience humility.

Think of the parable in the Gospel of Luke between the Pharisee and the tax collector. The Pharisee exalts himself and goes home unchanged. The tax collector, aware of his sin, beats his breast and says, *"O God, be merciful to me, a sinner."* And it is he who goes home justified. It is easy to fall into the trap of comparing ourselves to others, assuming that our external righteousness secures God's favor. But the Lord sees the heart. He is close to the humble, the contrite, the one who recognizes their need for mercy. Your heart is meant for God and it is important to invite our Blessed Lord into the depths.

Después de pasar unos días en un retiro en Asís, he regresado con gratitud por estar en casa. Aunque aquí en Phoenix las hojas no cambian de color como en Asís, el ritmo del año litúrgico siempre nos invita a una transformación más profunda del corazón, y ese es el cambio que realmente importa. Nos sentimos atraídos por una fe más profunda, la humildad y la confianza en Dios, y la perseverancia en vivir como hijos e hijas.

Qué hermosa frase de las Sagradas Escrituras para ayudarnos a reflexionar sobre nuestra vida hasta ahora: *"He luchado bien en el combate, he corrido hasta la meta, he perseverado en la fe."* Esta es una profunda convicción de nuestros corazones. San Pablo sabe que su hora se acerca, pero no tiene miedo. ¿Por qué? Porque sabe quién es. Confía en el juez justo, que todo lo ve, incluso cuando los demás no lo apoyan. Sus palabras nos ofrecen un poderoso aliento a todos, especialmente cuando nos sentimos ignorados o abandonados en nuestros esfuerzos por servir al Señor. Cuando nos mantenemos pequeños ante Dios, experimentamos la humildad.

Pensemos en la parábola del Evangelio de Lucas entre el fariseo y el recaudador de impuestos. El fariseo se exalta a sí mismo y se va a casa sin cambiar. El recaudador de impuestos, consciente de su pecado, se golpea el pecho y dice: «Dios mío, apiádate de mí, que soy un pecador». Y es él quien regresa a casa justificado. Es fácil caer en la trampa de compararnos con los demás, asumiendo que nuestra rectitud externa nos asegura el favor de Dios. Pero el Señor ve el corazón. Él está cerca de los humildes, de los contritos, de los que reconocen su necesidad de misericordia. Tu corazón está destinado a Dios y es importante invitar a nuestro Santísimo Señor a lo más profundo de él.
