Happy Sunday!

The Word of God this weekend gently but firmly draws our attention to a surprising truth that God delights in working through what the world often overlooks. The prophet Zephaniah urges us, *“Seek the Lord, all you humble of the earth”* (Zep 2:3), and promises that God will preserve a people *“humble and lowly”* who live in truth and trust (Zep 3:12-13). This is spiritual strength rooted in God.

Saint Paul reflects this message in his letter to the Corinthians, reminding us, through them, that God did not choose many by worldly standards of power or status, but rather the lowly, so that no one might boast except in the Lord (1 Cor 1:26-31). Our dignity does not come from what we achieve, accumulate, or control. Our dignity comes from belonging to Christ.

This truth reaches its fullest expression in the Beatitudes proclaimed by our Blessed Lord in the Gospel of Matthew. *“Blessed are the poor in spirit... blessed are the meek... blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness”* (Mt 5:1-12a). Our Lord does not bless suffering for its own sake, He blesses hearts that are open to God, hearts that rely on Him and allow His kingdom to take root.

As a parish, these readings speak directly to our mission. Evangelization begins with humility recognizing that we are first disciples before we are teachers. Catechesis flourishes when we allow ourselves to be continually formed by the Word and the teaching of the Church. Our sacramental life bears fruit when we approach the altar, the confessional, and the font with gratitude and trust in God’s mercy. Above all, these Sacred Scriptures call us to uphold the dignity of every human person. The Beatitudes remind us that God sees worth where the world may not, such as in the poor, the grieving, the persecuted, the unborn, the elderly, the forgotten. When we honor the dignity of each person, from conception to natural death, we make visible the kingdom that our Lord proclaims.

With humble and contrite hearts, receive my priestly blessing!

¡Feliz domingo!

La Palabra de Dios de este fin de semana nos llama la atención, con delicadeza pero con firmeza, sobre una verdad sorprendente: Dios se complace en obrar a través de lo que el mundo a menudo pasa por alto. El profeta Sofonías nos exhorta: *“Busquen al Señor, ustedes los humildes de la tierra”* (Sofonías 2:3), y promete que Dios preservará a un pueblo «humilde y sencillo» que vive en la verdad y la confianza (Sofonías 3:12-13). Esta es la fuerza espiritual que tiene su origen en Dios.

San Pablo se hace eco de este mensaje en su carta a los corintios, recordándonos, a través de ellos, que Dios no eligió a muchos según los criterios mundanos de poder o estatus, sino a los humildes, para que nadie pudiera jactarse excepto en el Señor (1 Corintios 1:26-31). Nuestra dignidad no proviene de lo que logramos, acumulamos o controlamos. Nuestra dignidad proviene de pertenecer a Cristo.

Esta verdad alcanza su máxima expresión en las Bienaventuranzas proclamadas por nuestro Señor en el Evangelio de Mateo. *“Bienaventurados los pobres de espíritu... Bienaventurados los mansos... Bienaventurados los que tienen hambre y sed de justicia”* (Mateo 5:1-12a). Nuestro Señor no bendice el sufrimiento por sí mismo, sino que bendice los corazones que están abiertos a Dios, los corazones que confían en Él y permiten que su reino eche raíces.

Como parroquia, estas lecturas se refieren directamente a nuestra misión. La evangelización comienza con la humildad de reconocer que primero somos discípulos antes que maestros. La catequesis florece cuando nos dejamos formar continuamente por la Palabra y la enseñanza de la Iglesia. Nuestra vida sacramental da fruto cuando nos acercamos al altar, al confesionario y a la pila bautismal con gratitud y confianza en la misericordia de Dios. Por encima de todo, estas Sagradas Escrituras nos llaman a defender la dignidad de cada persona humana. Las Bienaventuranzas nos recuerdan que Dios ve valor donde el mundo quizá no lo ve, como en los pobres, los afligidos, los perseguidos, los no nacidos, los ancianos, los olvidados. Cuando honramos la dignidad de cada persona, desde la concepción hasta la muerte natural, hacemos visible el reino que proclama nuestro Señor.

Con corazones humildes y contritos, ¡reciban mi bendición sacerdotal!

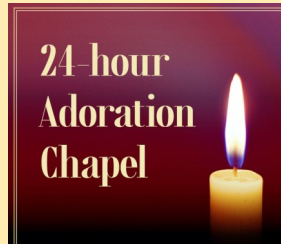


Universal Manifestation:
