## PARISH BEAUTIFICATION UPDATE

Parish Beautification Update! Since July 12, 1979 our parish of Saint Joan of Arc has been leading souls to Christ in very humble beginnings. Fast forward to 47 years later, our parish remains committed to fostering a family of faith called to live the love of Christ. In doing so, Christ's disciples are formed through the encounter in the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, Perpetual Eucharistic Adoration, forming young people to live a sacramental life and teach our students in our Preschool & Kindergarten. Adults seeking truth walk among us in the Order Christian Initiation for Adults, various events and activities foster fellowship and community. Many of us have experienced a gracious need for healing in body and soul. When time has come to finish this mission on earth, our loved ones were offered a Christian burial fitting for an anointed one.

After all these years, our buildings have endured a lot of wear and tear as a result of ordinary use. We strive to be good stewards of the sacrificial offerings to have our building stand. Now we face several challenges with our buildings as they are in need of repair and continued care and maintenance for the future.

Our Parish Beautification collection will focus on these repairs for the next six months and I am personally inviting you to help with a sacrificial offering of at least \$100 a month for the remainder of the year. If you are blessed to offer more, praise God for placing His Church first, it tells God I trust Him.

Below you will find the approximate costs of projects that need to be accomplished as soon as possible. The plan is to utilize our savings to cover the costs up front. However, we need to replenish our funds as we have additional building concerns in the future.

- Fire Alarm: repair in the church, Weidner Hall, preschool system ~\$85,000
- Roof Repair/Replacement: entire Weidner Hall roof replacement ~\$126,729
- HVAC: one unit replaced in the church (2026) ~\$70,000
- Another Church unit plus Santa Maria Hall unit (2027) ~\$120,000
- Church Floor Repair: replace broken tiles & weak areas ~\$7,000

Please pray for our parish under that patronage of Saint Joan of Arc.  
Together we can beautify our campus and allow it to last another 50 glorious years!

# ACTUALIZACIÓN SOBRE EL EMBELLECIMIENTO DE LA PARROQUIA

¡Novedades sobre el embellecimiento de la parroquia! Desde el 12 de julio de 1979, nuestra parroquia de Santa Juana de Arco ha estado guiando a las almas hacia Cristo desde sus humildes comienzos. 47 años después, nuestra parroquia sigue comprometida con fomentar una familia de fe llamada a vivir el amor de Cristo. Al hacerlo, los discípulos de Cristo se forman a través del encuentro en el Santo Sacrificio de la Misa, la Adoración Eucarística Perpetua, la formación de los jóvenes para que vivan una vida sacramental y la enseñanza a nuestros alumnos en nuestro preescolar y jardín de niños. Los adultos que buscan la verdad caminan entre nosotros en el Orden de Iniciación Cristiana para Adultos, y diversos eventos y actividades fomentan el compañerismo y la comunidad. Muchos de nosotros hemos experimentado una necesidad de sanación en cuerpo y alma. Cuando ha llegado el momento de terminar esta misión en la tierra, a nuestros seres queridos se les ha ofrecido un entierro cristiano digno de un ungido.

Después de todos estos años, nuestros edificios han sufrido un gran desgaste debido al uso habitual. Nos esforzamos por ser buenos administradores de las ofrendas sacrificiales para que nuestro edificio se mantenga en pie. Ahora nos enfrentamos a varios retos con nuestros edificios, ya que necesitan reparaciones y un cuidado y mantenimiento continuos de cara al futuro. Nuestra colecta para el embellecimiento de la parroquia se centrará en estas reparaciones durante los próximos seis meses y, personalmente, los invito a colaborar con una ofrenda de al menos 100 dólares al mes durante el resto del año. Si tienen la bendición de poder ofrecer más, alaben a Dios por poner a su Iglesia en primer lugar; eso le dice a Dios que confío en Él.

A continuación encontrarás los costos aproximados de los proyectos que deben realizarse lo antes posible. El plan es utilizar nuestros ahorros para cubrir los costos por adelantado. Sin embargo, necesitamos reponer nuestros fondos, ya que tenemos otras necesidades relacionadas con el edificio en el futuro.

- Alarma contra incendios: reparación en la iglesia, el Weidner Hall y el sistema del preescolar (approx: \$85,000)
- Reparación/sustitución del techo: sustitución completa del techo del Weidner Hall (approx: ~\$126,729)
- Climatización: 10 unidades tienen más de 20 años, Unidades de la Templo en 2026 (\$70,000)
- Unidades del Santa Maria Hall y Templo en 2027 (approx: ~\$120,000)
- Reparación del piso de la iglesia: reparación del piso de la iglesia (approx: \$7,000)

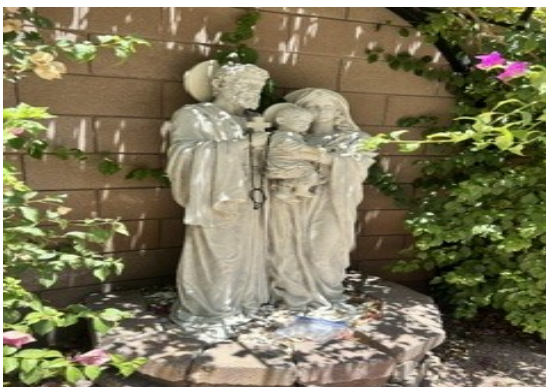

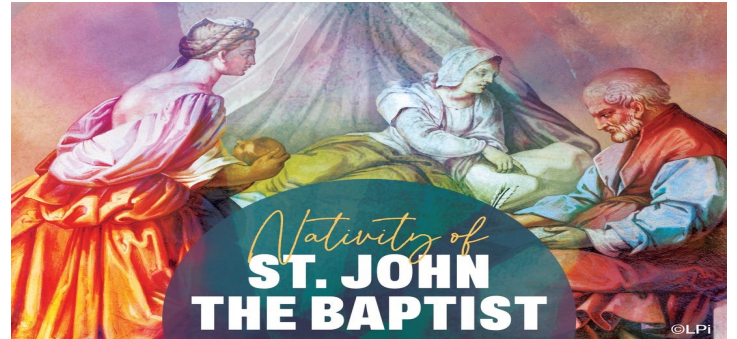

What is the difference between tithing and stewardship?

**Answer:**

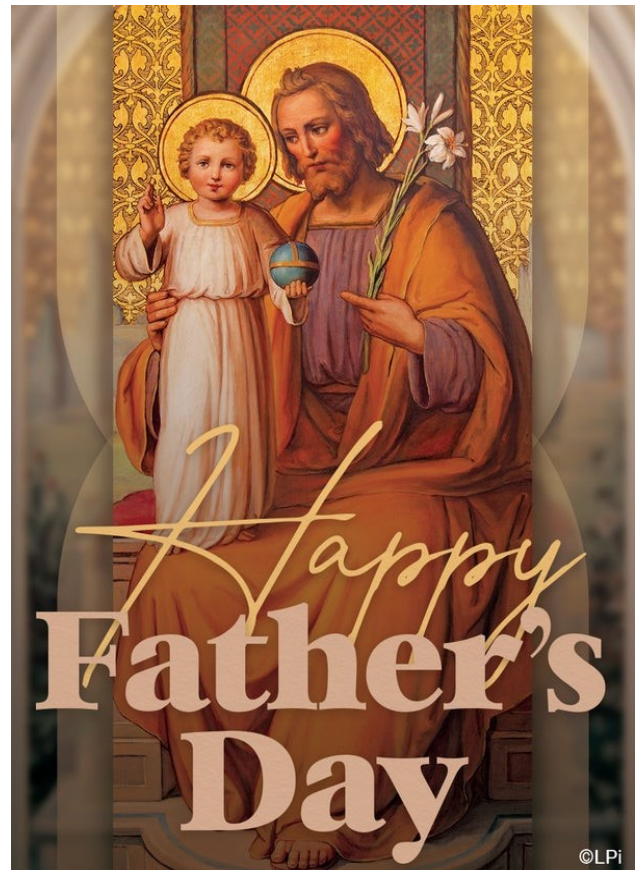
Both tithing and stewardship are part of a spiritual way of life that calls us to use all of our resources for the service of the Gospel.

Everything we are and everything we have comes from God. Offering back to God what He has given us is part of how we worship and give thanks to God.

Tithing is the practice of giving back 10 percent of what we earn. It comes from the Old English word for "ten." The first Scriptural example of tithing came from Abraham who gave a tenth of his possessions to the priest Melchizedek. He did so as an act of thanksgiving to God.

Stewardship as a way of life calls us to use well all that we have and all that we are, placing all things in service of others and God. Stewardship helps us see the good we can accomplish by making God and our spiritual life the most important values in our life. Whatever we accumulate in this life stays here. We can't take it with us! Both tithing and stewardship help us remember that nothing is mine or even ours ... all belongs to God.

As the warmer months approach, we kindly ask everyone to dress in a manner that reflects respect for our worship services and church community. While we understand the need to stay comfortable in the summer heat, we encourage attire that is modest, appropriate, and conducive to a reverent atmosphere.

Thank you for helping us maintain a welcoming and respectful environment for all.

### Virtues, Explained! Modesty

Modesty is a guide for how we interact with others in a way that honors their inherent dignity. According to the Catechism, modesty "protects the intimate center of a person" (CCC 2521).

One of the 12 fruits of the Holy Spirit is modesty, related to the cardinal virtue of temperance, or moderation of passions. It means "refusing to unveil what should remain hidden" and in doing so "protects the intimate center of the person" (CCC 2521). This virtue is a guide for how we interact with others in a way that honors their inherent dignity.

Christ notably said that those who look upon others with lust commit adultery in their heart (Matthew 5:28), indicating that modesty is concerned not just with action but with thoughts and interior disposition. Parents are obliged to instruct their children in the ways of modesty as part of teaching respect for others.

"The forms taken by modesty vary from one culture to another," we read in the Catechism. "Everywhere, however, modesty exists as an intuition of the spiritual dignity proper to man. It is born with the awakening consciousness of being a subject" (CCC 2524).

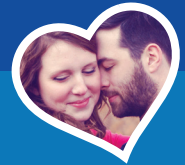

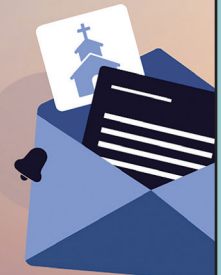
