Learning Focus:

Our class has been very busy practicing skills with the help of apples. We continue to work on letter identification, formation and sounds. A few are beginning to blend sounds to make words. The students are mastering their numbers 0-5 and learning about greater, less and equal. For Science we used our 5 senses, textures and apples. The class did not have a favorite apple, they liked them all. We ended the unit with making apple sauce, apple pies and tasting caramel apples. The favorite was the caramel apple. In Religion, we continue to learn the responses at Mass and all about God's Creation. In Social Studies we ended our unit on Community workers and Goods/ Service. We will begin exploring the symbols of the USA.
